Honeybee Craft

Tools and Materials

Yellow construction paper
Coffee filters
Pipe-cleaners
Wiggly eyes
Popsicle sticks
Scissors
Glue
Brown marker pen

Instructions

- 1. Using the yellow construction paper, draw and then cut out a circle for the bee's head, a slightly larger circle for its thorax and a longer oval for its abdomen.
- 2. Glue the three pieces along a popsicle stick, from smallest to largest, making sure they overlap each other slightly.
- 3. Colour brown stripes on each section.
- 4. Cut the coffee filter into four "pie" sections. Glue the pointed end of two sections onto each side of the bee's thorax: these are its wings.
- 5. Stick two wiggly eyes onto the bee's head.
- 6. Cut two pieces of pipe-cleaner and attach them to the bee's head: these are its antennae.
- 7. You can make different sizes of bees to represent worker bees, drones and a queen.
